TRINITY DOME - NATIONAL SHRINE COLLECTION

The Trinity Dome Collection will be collected on Mother's Day Weekend: May 13-14, 2017, a special collection for the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception's Trinity Dome in Washington, D.C. This collection is a one-time appeal to assist in bringing to completion the construction of the Great Upper Church begun in 1955. Proceeds will assist with the completion of the central and final dome in mosaic, The Holy Trinity.

The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception is the nation's preeminent Marian shrine, and is oftentimes affectionately referred to as America's Catholic Church. Open 365 days a year, the Basilica is host to nearly one million visitors annually, attracting pilgrims and tourists alike from across the country and around the world.
