EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The feeding of the multitudes is the only miracle of Jesus that is recorded in all four accounts of the Gospel, so it must have been extremely important to the first Christians. In this miracle, Jesus was teaching his followers a lesson that he explained further in his Bread of Life discourse. The point is that God has provided us with what we need most-Jesus himself is the bread of eternal life. The old testament readings emphasize that the things we eat and spend money on, can never really satisfy us. But God, in his compassion for us, offers what we really need-his love and forgiveness-all without price. We just have to accept it from him. "The Lord is near to all who call upon him". When we participate in the Eucharist, we become like the five thousand families that Jesus fed.

The Front doors are expected to be installed by late August. The archway mural and ceiling murals are expected to be done sometime in early Fall. Several more minor items are still in process and expected to be completed in the next month. Some deterioration issues with a couple of the sanctuary stained glass windows were discovered during renovation and we are in process of getting assessments and bids on those. While we don't have final figures on all of these items yet, it appears we are on budget, ie. that the money we have raised, plus what is pledged are going to match with expected expenses.
