TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Gospel reading continues Jesus' instructions on being good stewards of others – the direction that if we love Jesus Christ, we must forgive an individual 77 times.

The reading compels us to consider one of the most difficult practices of Christian discipleship. Forgiveness is the way of Jesus, the way of the cross. Vengeance, bitterness and hatred seem so much easier and certainly more desirable. Forgiveness is a hard road to travel, but it is the only road that leads to life in Christ. Consider this week who you need to forgive.

FAMILY CONVERSATION STARTER

Although it is not easy, sometimes we have to ask for forgiveness and say we are sorry for something we have done wrong.
