TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In Saint Paul's letter to the Romans he suggests that God lavishes his love upon us through Jesus Christ, who calls us to the kind of loving relationship, if we so choose it, that demands accountability. It is like, in Saint Paul's vocabulary, a kind of "debt" that we can never "pay-infull." But we begin to repay by following the direction of one of the most familiar statements in the Bible: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Good stewards realize that God does not call them just to love those who are easy to love, but to love the unloved and the hard-to-love people in this world as well. This week, remind yourself: "I am put here as an ambassador of God's love."

FAMILY CONVERSATION STARTER

Some people think that punishing a person who has done wrong will help that person not to do wrong again. Yet there are times that forgiving them may be a stronger encouragement. If we know that someone believes in us, we are more likely to want to live up to that trust.

All who attend Mass and other activities are highly encouraged to practice social distancing, use face masks and otherwise observe measures for the common good.

Everyone must use a face masks upon entering the church, during the Communion procession, and upon leaving the church. **If social distancing cannot be maintained in the pew, then the wearing of face masks is obligatory even in the pew.**
