It takes time and prayer to learn the spiritually powerfully meaning of the word "believe" in John's account of the Gospel. Believing does not mean merely acting as if something is real. Believing means developing the spiritual faculty to perceive the invisible reality at the heart of all things, analogous to the ability to see and hear the physical world. Two levels of seeing operate in John. Physical seeing leads to an embryonic form of faith, which remains tied to earthly forms of existence. But true believing enables one to see beyond physical sight.
