FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The phrase "spoken out boldly" uses a form of the Greek *parrhesia*. It combines the words for "everything" (*pan*) and "speaking" (*rhesis*). Words spoken with *parrhesia* say everything there is to be said. It suggests the act of communicating ideas directly, bluntly, without elaborate logic and vague metaphors—plain speaking.

Sharing the Gospel with others doesn't require fancy words, special knowledge or memorization of Scripture. Indeed, when we speak plainly and show the Gospel in our lives, we are sharing Jesus with others.

Love is more than a feeling of warmth toward another person; love is something to be lived in truth and action. Love is a choice we make each moment of our days.


