Bishop McKnight has updated the Decree on pastoral activities during the COVID-19 pandemic dated May 7, 2021. These changes will take effect June 1, 2021. The decree can be found on the Parish websites and also on the Diocese of Jefferson City website.

Beginning June 1:

- Holy Water will be at the entrance of church
- We will have servers, ushers and Sacristans.
- We will have the sign of Peace but ask that you do not shake hands but verbally send peace or otherwise acknowledge
- Offerings will be collected during mass
- There will no longer be a dispensation to attend mass. All healthy persons are to attend mass in person. Those that are ill or have a doctor's recommendation to not attend church are still granted the dispensation.
- Mass will still be recorded and uploaded for those who are granted a dispensation so that they may continue to view mass.

The St. Elizabeth Knights of Columbus will have a meeting Wednesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 pm at the Community Center.

Please come to the St. Lawrence Cemetery after the 10:00 o'clock Mass on Sunday, May 30, for the annual memorial ceremony to honor and remember soldiers from the community who gave their lives for their country, to recognize the graves of veterans, and to remember and pray for all the others who rest in peace. Sponsored by St. Elizabeth American Legion Post 545 for over 70 years, with Darren Wankum as the current Post Commander, this year's ceremony will include prayers and blessings by Fr. Joby and a special comment by the Post Historian, Dale Doerhoff, about the many lives lost during World War I to the influenza pandemic of 1918. One of those was Conrad Bode from St. Elizabeth. He was assigned to a medical unit in France to care for soldiers sick with influenza, contracted the disease while in the line of duty, and died shortly before the war ended. Medical experts at the time did not realize the disease was caused by a virus, something they learned after the war, and as a result failed to control the spread or effectively treat the disease. As a result, 45,000 American soldiers died from the pandemic, including many doctors, nurses, and medical aids like Conrad Bode. Please join us on Sunday after the 10:00 o'clock Mass to honor and remember their sacrifice.

Next Sunday is Corpus Christi Sunday and we will have a Eucharistic procession and Benediction inside the church after the 10:00 am Mass.

In preparation for the return of Sacristans, Servers and Ushers, please notify the Church Office if you no longer wish to participate. It will be assumed that if you do not notify the office that you will continue to be scheduled.

We ask that each family fill out a Parish Registration form that is included with this bulletin and on the Parish websites.
