### TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

When the Pharisees text Jesus on points of the law, Jesus pointed to the intimate relationship of men and women from the beginning of creation. Both are created in God's image, destined to live in relationship with one another.

For Jesus, marriage is a blessed relationship and the proper arena in which to fulfill the original biblical commands to be fruitful and multiply. Jesus does not specifically condemn divorce but lays out the ideal on which all marriages are based. The implication is that divorce is an aberration and a sign of the brokenness of the world. Jesus focused on the sanctity of marriage rather than the lawfulness of divorce.
