### TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Legend connects the book of Wisdom with Solomon who prays to God, not for riches or power, but for an understanding heart to govern the people. God grants his request and also rewards him with riches and glory beyond compare. Wisdom is feminine; she is depicted as the reflection of God and image of God's goodness. Ancient writers saw great beauty and treasure in Wisdom and considered her a pathway to God. The wisdom reading provides a nice counterpoint to the Gospel, where Jesus discusses the price of discipleship. Worldly wealth, possessions and relationships can stand in the way of the service of God. God must be the center of life, but the rich must work especially hard to overcome attachments to their worldly goods.

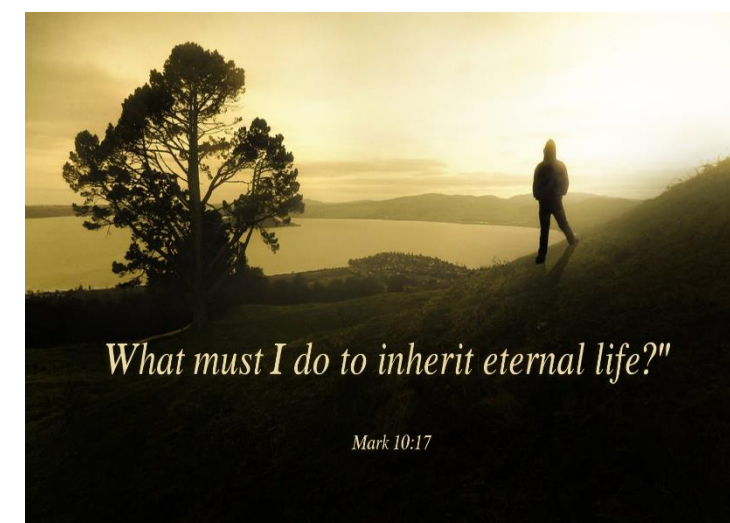
