16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The First Reading and Gospel of this weekend speak to us about welcome and hospitality. In the exercise of welcoming the other, we welcome God himself. The New Testament urges us in various passages not to fail to exercise hospitality. The Letter to the Hebrews says, "Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it" (Heb. 13:2). Today's homily can point out that "hospitality" is more than just a natural virtue or integral part of good manners. There is a "hospitality" that goes to the very depths of our relationship with God and our neighbor. The example of Abraham, Sarah, Martha, and Mary today point us to several key truths. First, the only proper response to the human person is welcome, acceptance, and love. Second, the opportunity to welcome the other comes at times we do not expect. Third, the welcome and hospitality we extend to others is, by that very fact, extended to God himself. Fourth, extending welcome can bring suffering and inconvenience to us – and this is the opportunity to live out what St. Paul describes in the Second Reading, uniting our sufferings with those of Christ.
