Bishop McKnight's August prayer intention for our Local Church

For a new commitment to building an America where children are welcomed, cherished and cared for; where mothers and fathers are encouraged and strengthened; and where marriage and the family are recognized and supported as the true foundations of a healthy and flourishing society.

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings show us the suffering that God's chosen must often endure to bring people closer to God. The prophet Jeremiah is cast into a pit. The author of the second reading urges us to keep "our eyes fixed on Jesus" so that we do not "lose heart" (Heb 12:2, 3), and Jesus himself warms of the hornet's nest that his mission will stir up.

The sharp language and dramatic imagery in today's Gospel reading have been borrowed by Luke from Jewish prophetic and apocalyptic writing to express the cataclysmic significance of Jesus' teachings. His message is so radical that it will have dramatic effects—as if the earth had been set on fire.

Jesus did not come to "establish peace but rather division" (Lk 12:51). The race we are called to run is not easy. Being a witness to Christ means standing up to injustices and speaking truth to power.
