### Bishop McKnight's September prayer intention for our Local Church

For all who serve in our community as first responders: that God may protect them from all harm, and that we be grateful for the sacrifices they make for the common good.



When was the last time you felt humbled? Today's first reading may challenge those of us who cherish accolades and achievements—so, likely all of us! Being recognized or thanked for our work isn't bad thing in itself. But Sirach reminds us God does not work on a merit system. God does not need you to do anything special or be anyone else in order to be fully loved. We need only to humbly accept God's gift—and give thanks.

In today's Gospel, Luke explains that people should not presume to place oneself above other members but should live in humility. This becomes a key aspect of discipleship in all four Gospel accounts: to live humbly as Christ did.

#### Synopsis of St. Anthony Parish/Finance Council meeting

•It was decided to hold off on updating the Confessional at this time. •The retaining wall and basement steps on the back side of the Parish Hall have been braced. We could not find a contractor who was willing to make the repairs needed. •Railings on the steps coming out of the kitchen on the back side of the Parish Hall will be installed.

•We will be replacing the floor in the men and women's restrooms in the Parish Hall. •Water lines will be capped for those properties that were on the church well but have sold. A new septic tank will be installed along with new lateral lines, and the tree outside the women's restroom in the hall will be taken out all at once. Bids are being sought. •We are trying to obtain bids for guttering across the front of the Parish Hall. •Kevin Otto will be sealing the bell tower to prevent water from running into the church. •Church council members will continue to count the number of people attending Mass on Sunday's and Holy Days for now. In the future, other church groups, such as Knights of Columbus, the Ladies' Auxiliary, etc. may be asked to help. •A welcome party for Father Aubuchon will be held on Sunday, September 18 at noon at the St. Anthony Park. •Donna Dickneite will take over the Hall Rental Calendar. •The Diocese had Willet Hauser appraise the condition of the stained-glass windows in the church. They also gave an appraisal of replacement value of \$70,884. •The financial report was presented. Expenses were less than income. Offertory collections were up nearly \$20,000 from last year. •Some new items are needed for the Hall including a vacuum cleaner, several roasters and some new tables. •Pastoral Plan will be included in the bulletin for the parishioner's knowledge. •Thursday evening Masses after Labor Day will be moved to 6 p.m. Masses will remain at 6 p.m. from that point forward; they will not change with the seasons. Adoration will follow the 6:00 pm Mass on First Friday due to the earlier Mass time.
