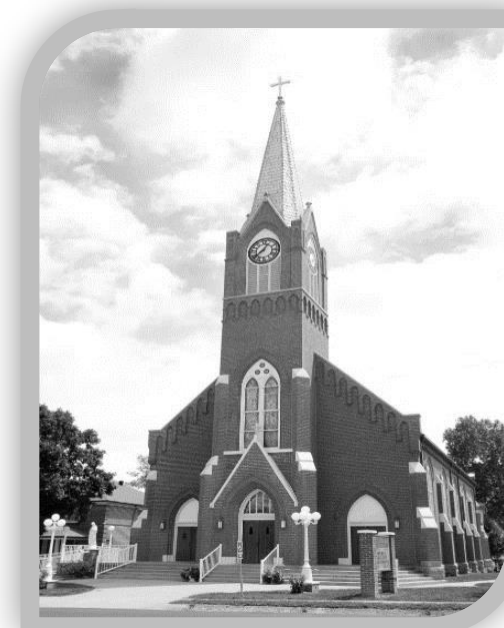

**31<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Today's Gospel is simple; a tax collector climbs a tree in order to see Jesus better. Here in, Luke focuses on Zacchaeus' intention to seek out Jesus and the Lord's immediate acceptance. The crowds, however, misunderstand who is truly righteous when they grumble that Jesus has eaten with a sinner. But Zacchaeus' answer vindicates Jesus' decision to dine with him and Jesus' entire mission. Now it is not the tax collector who is lost but the crowds who misjudged. Zacchaeus is a model for their own relationship with God and so brings salvation closer to all of them.
