Sunday, February 5, 2023 – Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the verses preceding today's Gospel, Jesus begins the Sermon on the Mount with the Beatitudes. As Moses formed God's people by giving them the old law on Mount Sinai, so Jesus, the new Moses, forms a new people by giving them his new law. Paul argues that God's power, God's grace, works through the lives of believers by attracting many to follow and accept the Good News. The prophet Isaiah offered the same idea. The witness of an authentic life attracts people to the message. The prophet affirms this vision: "If you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then your light shall rise for you in the darkness."
