Sunday, May 14, 2023 – Sixth Sunday of Easter

In the reading from Acts, the life of the early Church flourishes through the power of the Holy Spirit. Hearing that the Word of God had been preached to the Samaritans, the apostles send Peter and John to empower them with the gift of the Holy Spirit as "they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus" (Acts 8:16). As Jesus came "to baptize with the Holy Spirit" (John 1:33), the apostles confer the gift of the Holy Spirit by "laying hands on them" (Acts 8:17). Here the foundation for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation is expressed clearly.

The Ascension of the Lord Year A (2023)

Traditionally, the Ascension of Our Lord is held 40 days after Easter, falling on a Thursday. However in most dioceses in the United States, the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord is moved to the following Sunday, superseding the 7th Sunday of Easter.

The feast of the Ascension of the Lord Year A commemorates the day that Jesus Christ ascended into heaven. He also gave the Great Commission, that all of the world should be saved. In the first reading the Ascension of Jesus is recounted and the Apostles are told they will receive the Holy Spirit. In the second reading, we hear that Jesus Christ rules heaven and earth. And in the gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to preach the Good News to the whole world.


