Gracious God,

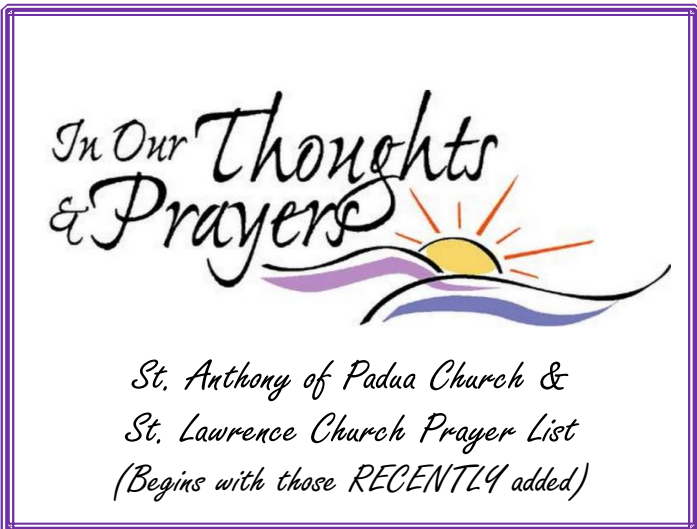

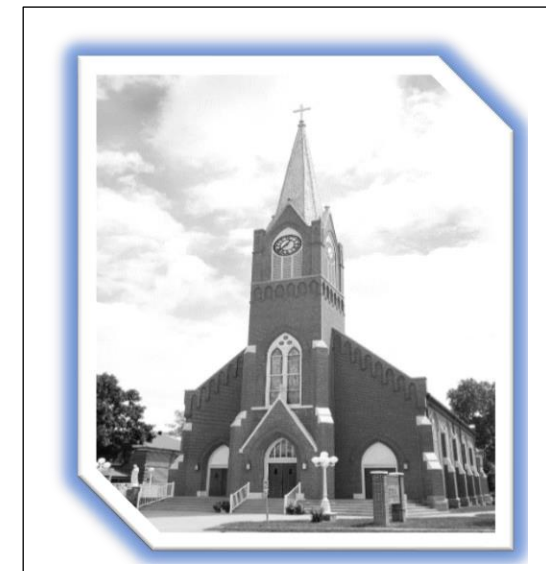
