

<u>Sunday, August 13, 2023 – Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time</u>: We see Jesus' faithful determination to save in our Gospel reading today. Although the disciples mistake Him as a ghost and Peter doubts, Jesus walks on the stormy sea to join them and reaches out to save a sinking Peter. To have faith in Jesus requires courage. It entails knowing we proclaim the truth in Christ. The courage we have to live our faith comes from Jesus himself. He calms our fears and saves us as we walk on the waves of life!

<u>Tuesday, August 15, 2023 - The Assumption of the Blessed Mother</u>: As Elizabeth exclaims in Luke 1:42, Mary is blessed because She bears the Living God. The woman in today's Gospel passage declares there is something special about Jesus that honors and elevates His Mother. Mary was probably startled by Jesus' invitation that She become blessed herself, not by bearing a son of importance, but by believing and living what Jesus taught. Our celebration of Mary's Assumption into Heaven is a celebration of eternal life. We pray we will hear and observe God's Word so we too will be joyously welcomed into eternal life with our God.
