

The **Act of Contrition** is a powerful prayer of penance that is prayed after confessing one's sins to a priest during the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). After making an act of contrition, the priest will grant absolution to the penitent (person making his/her confession), absolving him/her of their sins by the grace of God. Here are two most common Act of Contrition Prayers.

Act of Contrition Prayer

O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of heaven and the pains of hell,
But most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life.

Amen

Act of Contrition Prayer

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin.

Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In His Name. My God have mercy.
