



Sunday, March 3, 2024 – Third Sunday of Lent: Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God... The words roll off our tongues so easily. Of course Jesus is God's wisdom and power! "Jesus, fill me with your wisdom and power so I can share them with everyone around me!"


