### Sunday, May 4, 2025 – Daily Reflection

The Acts of the Apostles contains such amazing stories that it can sometimes seem like we are reading a work of fiction. But that's just not the case. Take today's first reading...there really were men and women who, in the face of severe persecution, kept filling Jerusalem with the Good News. Peter and the apostles really were questioned, tortured, and imprisoned, but they didn't back down. Instead, they replied, "We must obey God rather than men." It might be hard to relate to such boldness, so imagine how, in your own world, you can "fill" the places and spaces with the Good News of Jesus Christ. Think about your everyday activities, places you go, people you come in contact with; maybe it's family at home, people at work or school, or just waiting in line somewhere. Now picture those places as your own "Jerusalem" and imagine the Good News of the saving love and mercy of God bubbling up inside you! As you feel His presence, you may hold your head higher, smiler boarder, and look for someone to share it with. So now, without hesitation, open the "gate" and offer prayer for someone in need, strike up a conversation, or maybe open the door or give someone your seat or place in line. Actions speak louder than words. THIS IS YOU filling your own "Jerusalem" with the Gospel!

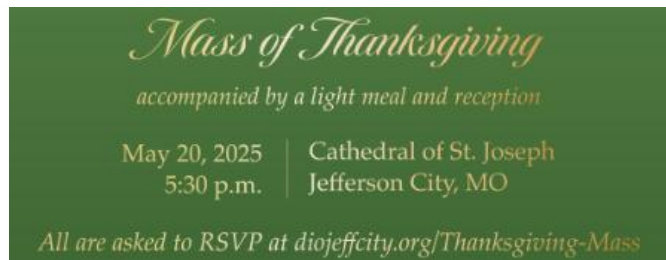

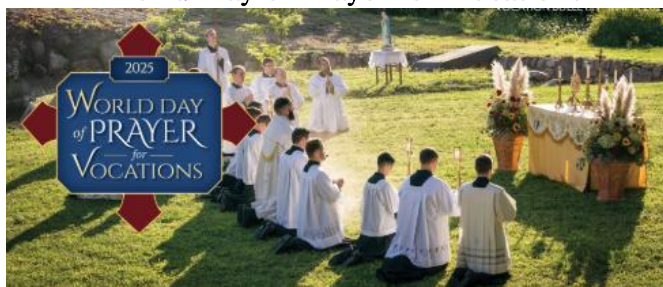
