



Sunday, June 15, 2025 – Daily Reflection: It's no coincidence we celebrate Trinity Sunday on the Sunday after Pentecost. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is so deep that we need the Holy Spirit, the "Spirit of Truth", to help us understand it. And even more important, it's only through the Holy Spirit, who was poured out on Pentecost, that we can enter into an ever-deepening relationship with our awesome triune God! Triune means God is not a single entity but rather exists as a Trinity of three distinct persons, each with their own unique role. With that, it's the Holy Spirit who moves us to pray and worship God. He both puts that desire in our hearts and teaches us to pray. He opens our ears so that we can hear God speaking to us, and he opens our hearts so that we can come to know the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in a personal way. Perhaps not amazing, it's the Holy Spirit who pours "the love of God....into our hearts". We know intellectually that God is love, but the Holy Spirit helps us experience the immensity of that love. He shows us that we are the apple of God's eye, beloved from before time began. On this special feast, let the Holy Spirit speak a word of reassurance to you about our mysterious, awe-inspiring God. You will never fully grasp the mystery of the Trinity, but you CAN be grasped by it.

"Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I will praise you forever!"

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION – June 22 at St. Lawrence, 10 AM Mass

The words "Corpus Christi" means "Body of Christ" and are another name for the "Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ". The Solemnity is celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday and, marks with particular emphasis, the doctrine of Christ's real presence—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the Eucharist. In celebrating the Solemnity, the Corpus Christi Procession will be held (weather-permitting) at St. Lawrence immediately following the 10:00 AM Mass.

Why should we participate in the Corpus Christi procession? The annual procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi has a special importance and meaning for the pastoral life of the parish and community. When the Eucharist is carried through the street/parish, in a solemn procession with singing, parishioners and people of faith, give public witness of their devotion toward the Sacrament.
